## Drop-in therapy sessions for early communication skills

For children from birth to the end of nursery

### We can help if your child has difficulties:

- Understanding words, sentences and instructions.
- Using words and sentences, pronouncing words.
- Talking - stammering, a husky/hoarse voice.
- Social skills and play.

### Your visit will include:

- Talking about your concerns with a speech and language therapist.
- A brief assessment of your child's speech and language skills. A Speech and Language Therapist will do this by watching and joining in with your child in a play situation.
- An opportunity to give you advice on how to encourage your child to talk.

### What happens next:

- You're welcome to visit us again if you need further advice.
- Your child may be offered another assessment.
- Your child may be offered speech and language therapy.
